Ceremony can change our life and existence as we know it on a small and large scale.

The 2012 Summer Solstice Ceremony proved to be one of the most powerful ceremonies that we have experienced at Starseed and we believe that it will have far reaching effects.

We were a diverse group of twelve arriving from as far as Canada, each being drawn to come by an attraction that could not be denied. It was only two hours before the exact solstice time that it became clear that the ceremony would consist of burning two large wood sculpture pieces that had been identified as representing the matriarchy and the patriarchy. The ceremony consisted of the ceremonial burning of these old paradigms and all the old dysfunctional and imbalanced ways of relating that are perpetuated by control and fear producing thought forms and structures. The awareness that came through was that an entirely new way of being in relationship with ourselves, each other and the universe is required. It is not yet known what this new way will be but it is quite clear that it will be completely based in love.

During the ceremony we acknowledged the good we had received from the matriarchy and the patriarchy, we fed the fires and released all that could hold us back from co-creating a sustainable, loving and peaceful way to live on earth and in the universe. The Matriarchy transmuted easily, she gave herself over in a very graceful, nurturing and beautiful way. The patriarchy did not surrender easily. We had to burn it all night and into the next day, all the time being aware that we were called to hold the space for the complete release to the core of the patriarchy system. When only the hard and unrelenting core of the piece was left we tried to smash it with a metal rake. As we did this, waves of dark black smoke spewed forth from the core. We put it back into the fire to burn it completely, and as it finally let go of its last stand, the words came forth, "The Patriarchy looks small and helpless in the fires of love."
